## London Olympics 2012

For the first time in 64 years, the Olympics are coming to London and this summer, our capital will host a number of exciting sporting and cultural events to mark the occasion. The countdown is on:

### Olympic Sports for Free!

For all those sports fanatics who missed out on Olympic tickets, there are a number of free Olympic events that can be watched right from the sidelines!:

**Road Cycling:** A gruelling cycling race starting at The Mall in central London and moving South West through the city

**Race Walk:** 20k speed-walking race in central London, finishing at The Mall, where competitors must keep one foot on the ground at all times.

**Marathon:** The marathon passes all of our iconic London sites, and comes as far as Trafalgar Square (2 minutes from school!)



### Cultural Olympiad

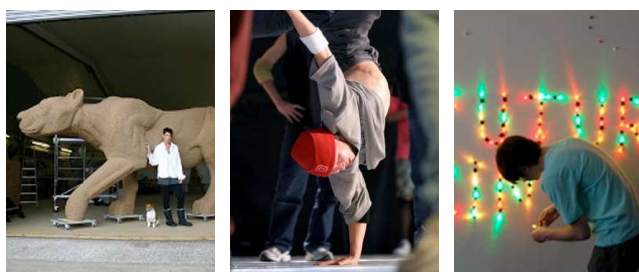
The Cultural Olympiad is a series of cultural events and celebrations, officially linked to the 2012 Olympics. Billed as one of the biggest celebrations ever seen in the UK, events include:

- A series of **music festivals** in central London parks
- Ground-breaking **art exhibitions** at the Royal Academy
- A World **Shakespeare Festival**
- **Artistic projects** throughout the city
- Free **workshops** on art, photography, filmmaking, England and much more!

### Transport

**Flights:** London airports are set to be at full capacity this summer, so we recommend our students book flights as early as possible. But don't worry, for late bookings there are still a number of options available.

**London:** The most seriously affected areas of London will be Stratford, Wembley, Wimbledon, Greenwich and some parts of Central London. At Regent London we are lucky enough to be a 10-minute walk from 8 different stations, meaning it will be one of the most accessible areas this summer!



### Accommodation

With London being the most popular destination this summer, housing across London is already filling up fast. Regent London has secured accommodation across the city to ensure that our students have the best options this summer:

**Nevern House:** We continue with the same fantastic allocation at Nevern House throughout the summer with both standard and en-suite rooms.

**Summer Residence:** This summer we have guaranteed an allocation of 79 rooms in this residence just 10 minutes by foot from the school.

**Homestay:** We have doubled the number of host families we work with this year to ensure that we have available families in the best locations.
