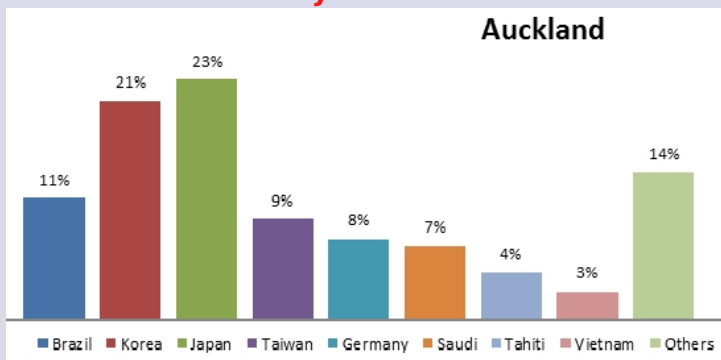


It's SUMMER in New Zealand!

Feather dale Wildlife Park

Wentworth Falls

Our eco accredited guide will take you on an amazing bushwalk through the national park. Stone hop across a stream, follow the edge of the cliff, see awesome views, take great photos from lookouts and sandstone caves and see a stunning waterfall.

BBQ Lunch

Australia is the land of BBQs so after your exhilarating bushwalk you'll enjoy a classic Aussie traditional sausage sizzle. We'll also cook up some kangaroo meat or 'bush tucker' for you to try.

The Three Sisters

The famous Three Sisters rock formation is one of the most iconic images in Australia. The views overlooking the Jamison Valley are incredible and as well as getting that classic photo, you'll hear the stories of the local Aboriginal legends.

Scenic Railway (not included)

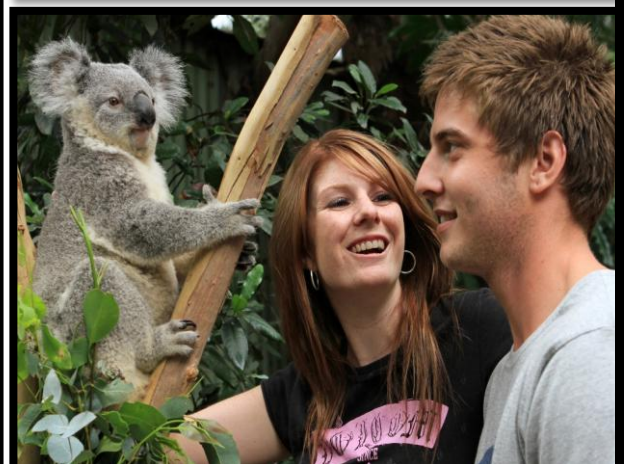
